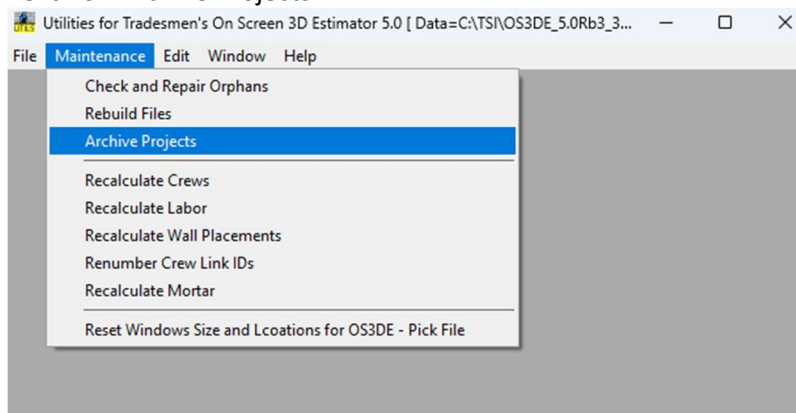

Project Archive Procedure

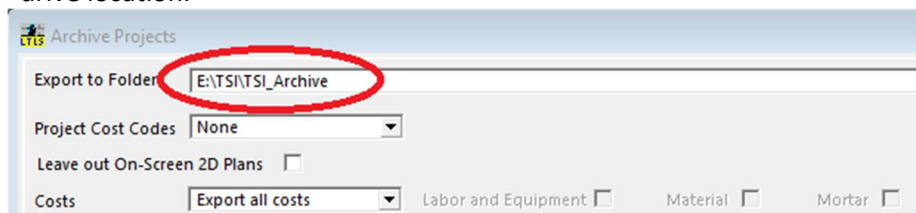
1. Close the OS3DE program.
2. Go to \TSI\OS3DE and open OS3DE Utilities by launching the OS3DE_Utils.exe

3. Click on Maintenance
4. Click on Archive Projects



5. Set Export Folder to an existing, valid location. Preferably a network drive or external hard drive location.



6. Select the archival options you would like to use.

- **Project Cost Code Options:** None, Project Specific or ALL. Project Specific or ALL only apply if you are working with the Job Cost Transfer Module.
- **Leave out On-Screen 2D Plans checkbox.** This is to be checked if you do **NOT** want the plan image files to accompany the project. This is an old option intended to save on disc space, it is not recommended today... Hopefully you have plenty of disc space available.
- **Costs:** Most likely to use Export All Costs. There are 2 other options to Check Costs to Remove or Remove All Costs.
- **[###] Number of Projects in the current Project List/Data Set.** This number does not change until the archive procedure is complete.
- **Export Projects Matching these Conditions:** Pick at least one of the 4 options and change from [Ignore] to your choice of one (or more) of the four Blank/Not Blank/Before/After/Hidden/Not Hidden selections to compile Projects to be Exported. The most commonly used conditions are Bid Date/Before or Last Touched/Before.
- **[###] Projects To Be Exported.** This number will change depending on the variables that were entered/changed with the Export Project Conditions.
- **Successfully Exported Projects Should be Options:** Deleted, Just Exported or Hidden. One option will need to be selected.

-Deleted - Deleted from existing Project List, remove from data set.

-Hidden - Hides Project in the Project List.

-Just Exported - Exports Projects and ALL Projects remain in the data set.
